Non SouthEast/SouthCentral Educational Cooperative members or schools may join for a membership fee of \$1.50 per student (ADA) The Collaborative service area includes the SE/SC Educational Cooperative service area, the Eastern Kentucky University service area and any school or district within a 150 mile radius of ECU campus.
